The appointment letter issued to Independent Directors inter alia sets out the expectation of the Board from the appointed Director, their fiduciary duties and responsibilities that come with the appointment as a Director of the Company, along with the details of remuneration and performance review process. The Independent Directors are appraised at Board Meetings on the Company operations, market shares, governance, internal control processes and other relevant matters. They are also updated on important changes in the regulatory framework and business environment having an impact on the Company.

The Board members are updated on various regulatory and other amendments and developments either by way of presentations by external experts / consultants or by internal experts. The Independent Directors were also given a detailed overview of the SEBI (LODR) Regulations, 2015 as amended from time to time.
