

Disaster Management – Pandemic Intervention

The lockdown imposed to curb the impact of pandemic, affected the migrant workers and daily wage earners the most. To provide relief in such situations, kitchens were set up in numerous locations as a daily source of hygienic and healthy food for the needy. The Department of Police extended its support to this initiative and helped in distributing eatables in various communities. Healthy food kits containing cooked food and dry ration were distributed among 44,316 families in many areas of Maharashtra and Gujarat.

During the pandemic, the frontline workers risked their lives while looking after the COVID

patients. To support and protect them, the Foundation provided them with complete safety kits. For the government hospitals, the Foundation arranged lifesaving drugs to bring down the mortality rate and counter the severity of the virus.

Navneet Foundation supported a COVID Jumbo Centre in Mumbai, by providing the RO plant for continuous availability of hygienic water at the centre.

Social distancing was difficult to maintain in prisons, putting the prisoners at risk of contracting COVID-19. To ensure hygiene and

minimise the risks of the virus, the Foundation provided towels, napkins, bathing and washing soaps among 250 inmates in Kutch, Gujarat.

The transport of goods became a major challenge during the lockdown. The Foundation arranged stocks of important medicines for the Psychiatric and Medical Hospital in Kutch, which were unavailable during the lockdown.

Blood transfusion was critical for the treatment of the COVID patients and Mumbai did not have enough donors. For the well-being of such patients, the Foundation supported two blood plasma donation camps organised by an NGO in Mumbai.

Students in rural areas found it difficult to continue their studies during the lockdown. Learning and connecting with teachers was a challenge. The Foundation made available its digital education programs for more than 15,000 students in various parts of Maharashtra, helping students to continue on their path of education.



Health and Medical Intervention – Extending Medical Help During the Pandemic

Our Foundation has taken on the task of aiding patients for numerous years via the building of hospitals in Maharashtra and Gujarat. With focus of most of the health service providers towards COVID management, it became increasingly important to lend support to patients battling other ailments.






Supporting Education Initiatives for a Brighter Tomorrow

We believe education is a right of every child and literacy is the way to unlock a bright future.

Navneet Foundation provided coaching and mentoring to nearly 447 underprivileged youths who were pursuing a career in administrative and civil services. Financial support took care of the education fees of 323 children of needy families, along with 35 girls who received mentorship and coaching for higher studies. Furthermore, financial help for education was also extended to 31 children who were undergoing cancer treatment. Motivational and educational books were also distributed in 400 libraries in Guiarat.

The English-learning program supported by the Foundation saw the participation of 900 children. In the quest to support the educational institutions, the Foundation provided for the repair and maintenance of two schools serving underprivileged children in the state of Gujarat. Books and school kits were also distributed among 600 children to support their education.





Case Studies

Kajal Lambe was pursuing final year in B.Sc. Lab Technician and has worked as an intern with Tata Memorial Hospital in the past. She took this pandemic as an opportunity to serve society and showed courage to work in the COVID Department of K.E.M Hospital, a government-aided hospital for four months. She had to stay in the hospital, away from her family. Due to the increase in the COVID Cases, she used to work relentlessly the entire day, and at the end of the day when she used to call her mom and dad both of them used to say "Beta you are my real hero, tum Hamara nam roshan karogi, tum haar mat mano aage badhti jao ham tumare Sath har samay rahenege". These power pack words of her parents motivated her to keep going. She felt proud of herself and was happy that because of the field she chose she got the chance to help the covid patients and give back to the society."





Bhagyashree Chinkeri was pursuing B. Com final year. Her father lost his job due to Covid. She completed a Career Readiness Program and post-completion they provided job placements. She got opportunity to work in covid ward Brihanmumbai Municipal Corporation (BMC). This opportunity turned out to be a ray of light during this dark time. Her role was to get the details of the infected patients, update the containment zone area and sealed buildings (on google map), provide daily data of Covid facilities like quarantine centers, hospitals and keep an attendance record of doctors, nurses, volunteers and ward boys/girls. She received support from her family and her father told her, "Beta mehnat ka fal hamesha milta hai, par uske liye thoda patience rakhna padta hai."



Teacher's Training Program

On 5th September 2020, celebrated as 'Teacher's Day', the foundation launched a new portal 'NavDisha', to meet the needs arising from the crisis of the pandemic. The portal connected numerous teachers and educators and provided workshops and training to conduct efficient online learning. Various webinars guided the teachers in hosting quality education classes via digital platforms and developing professional skills. The platform is a forward progress to adapt to the crisis and changes in the education system. Many experts trained the teachers through webinars on topics like education during the pandemic, COVID and its effect on the psychology of students, and cyber security. 'NavDisha' also provided access to numerous thematic articles,

interviews, and other educational materials conducted by senior and expert teachers, Q&As and problem-solving, circulars and resolutions (GRs) issued by the Government.

An unique initiative was taken for the benefit of students of class X to prepare them for the board examination. During lockdown the online teaching could not reach all the students. The inputs and guidelines given to teachers through a series of webinars enabled them to prepare their students well for the board exams. The viewership of these sessions increased to 75,000 towards the scheduled exams. The students also availed the expert sessions to enhance their preparedness for examinations.









The platform was successful in impacting more than 1,00,000 teachers across Maharashtra. Academic webinars in Languages, Social Sciences, Mathematics, and much more were watched by nearly 20,000 teachers. This helped the teachers in improving their teaching methods and strategies in online classes.

Animal Welfare

Covid-19 Affecting The Voiceless

Due to the lockdowns, people could not look after the needs of the distressed animals and birds. The foundation provided fodder for 250 cattle and feed for 500 birds in Mumbai. Furthermore, 150 animals were provided with the necessary medical treatment. The Foundation also supported more than 188 organisations that were looking after the food, medical and shelter needs of nearly 10,000 cattle and other animals.

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Community And Tribal Development







The core values of community development programs of the foundation are sustainable development and people participation. The process involved community assessment by Participatory Rural Appraisal. Meetings were held in villages and tribes to get a better understanding of their problems and propose solutions. The programs included better access to health and income generation sources. The initiative was implemented in the states of Maharashtra, Assam, Bihar and Meghalaya.

This intervention with tribal communities led to nearly 100,000 families becoming debt-free and achieving a joint saving of nearly ₹ 17 crores. The community intervention programs undertook skill development initiatives amongst the tribal villagers. Women were motivated to become financially empowered by income generation programs, leading to more than 2,200 women participating in mushroom farming, which is a profitable venture in the region. Almost 1,145 farmers were trained in organic farming techniques, which helped them in expanding their market outreach.

A healthy mind is paramount to a healthy life. As a part of society, it is our responsibility to look after those facing mental pressures or trauma. To help such people stay motivated and enthusiastic, psychiatric medical services were made available to 300 patients in these areas.

The Foundation extended its support to the dairy business run by 3,000 women. This initiative helped expand its market through three retails shops for the sale of milk and milk products in Lonavla, Pune and Talegaon.

The tribes in the outskirts of Mumbai were dealing with the risk of crop destruction by small animals. Some farmers built fences by using old sarees to protect their farm yields and the strategy was successful. To help roll out this sustainable conservation idea, the Foundation organized a saree collection drive in the region, providing 100 farmers with sarees to ensure the safeguarding of their farms.

Other Initiatives

Work with Special Needs

A web series was launched to promote the success stories and achievements of people with special needs. They shared their stories of struggle and achievements through 10 episodes of a webseries. The webseries is available on social media platforms.



The series is an inspiration and motivation to society and enhances opportunities to provide opportunities to the specially-abled individuals. Individuals and organisations were

felicitated with a token of appreciation for their contribution to the society.

Sports Development

Two badminton players (under 16), Naisha Bhatoye and Pranay Shettigar were supported in their training, health and fitness. Diga Chitale, tennis player (under 18) was supported for International and domestic training and tournaments, International Coaching, and Nutrition. Medical tests and assessments. Mountaineer Keval Kaka was supported in completing

Tri-summit, making him the first ever Indian to conquer 3 peaks above 8,000 m viz Mt. Makalu (8,485 m); Mt. Kangchenjunga (8,586 m); Mt. Annapurnal (8,091 m).

Also, 352 youth and children were coached in cricket and participated in local, district and state level matches.





Environment Development

Indegenious medicinal plants and herbs planted in Primary Heath Centre were made accessible to villagers in tribal areas. This Herbal Gardern was developed by Navneet Foundation.
